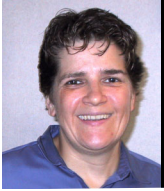

## What's the Word...



Since the introduction of the first digital hearing aids in 1996, advances in the technology have been constant. The last couple of years are no exception. One of the most exciting new advances is Bluetooth capability being added to some hearing devices. With Bluetooth connectivity, patients are able to have cell phone conversations while listening through BOTH of their hearing aids, totally hands-free! Other Bluetooth devices can be connected as well. Microphone technologies are better than ever before! There are technologies that offer an optional remote for setting the directionality of the microphones to which ever direction you would like. If you have someone in the backseat of your car, for example, with the push of a button, the microphones can be switched toward the back to reduce the noise from in front and the side so you can carry on a conversation more easily. For those of you with severe to profound loss who are

always looking for more power, a new super power behind-the-ear hearing aid has been introduced by Phonak. It uses a unique processing that moves sounds in frequencies where there is little to no hearing sensitivity, down to areas where hearing sensitivity is better.
